### Process for admission to PG courses at Aravind Eye Hospital & Post graduate Institute of Ophthalmology

(Affiliated to The Tamil Nadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Govt. of Tamil Nadu)

**MS course** : 12 Seats ( Government Quota = 08 seats)  
(Management Quota = 04 seats)

**DO course** : 08 seats ( Government Quota = 05 seats)  
(Management Quota = 03 seats)

**Admission process** : Merit Rank through NEET Score

**Allocation of seats (Government and Management seats) by Selection Committee, Directorate of Medical Education, Kilpauk, Chennai.**

## **Service obligation:**

### **MS course**

Similar to the prospectus of the Government of Tamil Nadu PG admission courses and rules, the post graduate (non-service government quota candidates as well as management quota candidates) are required to serve Aravind Eye Hospital for a period of 2 years after successful completion of the course, failing which they should pay a compensation amount of **Rs. 40 lakhs**. They will be required to sign an agreement in a Bond paper to this effect.

### **DO course**

Similar to the prospectus of the Government of Tamil Nadu PG admission courses and rules, the post graduate (non-service government quota candidates as well as management quota candidates) are required to serve Aravind Eye Hospital for a period of 2 years after successful completion of the course, failing which they should pay a compensation amount of **Rs. 20 lakhs**. They will be required to sign an agreement in a Bond paper to this effect.
