2. Only students who are willing to spend a minimum period of 4 months to a maximum of six months, without any break, would be eligible for the programme.
3. AMRF will not provide any fellowship or financial support towards transport or accommodation facilities.

Students are requested to follow the prescribed procedure for admission and NOT to approach individual scientists for the project. Applications must be forwarded by the Head of the Department.
